

Spread Hope and Help during this Season of Giving!



- Ethiopia Medical Project supports the poorest elderly in their community of Buccama. They have asked for help to give their residents *blankets and new mattresses, as well as needed flour, oil, and soap.*
- When our care partners in Nangwa Village, Tanzania visited their elderly clients to deliver needed supplies, they noticed that **some did not even have basic essential items such as mattresses and blankets, while others were living in very poorly-built, dilapidated shelters. They seek our support for buying timber and wood to reinforce the homes (pictured at left) as well as mattresses and blankets.**
- Our care-partner in Rwanda has requested assistance to buy kitenge, trousers, and shirts for the vulnerable elderly in and around Kirambi, and some funds to enable them to share a holiday meal together.
- In Kenya, our care partner serves impoverished, elderly slum-dwellers, and has asked for resources to allow these destitute elderly to share food with loved ones during the holiday season.
- Aniemezie A. (74) in Nigeria has remained crippled from birth. He is unmarried and has no family of his own. To support himself, he makes local brooms from palm fronds which earns him about \$8 per month. He depends on neighbors and Michael's House to survive, even more so since the price of food and goods have increased.
